

# Fox Haven Country Club Member-Guest

Date: August 20th & 21st (Saturday & Sunday)

Format/Scoring:

45-hole, match play event with 27 holes (three nine-hole matches) on Saturday and 18 holes (two nine-hole matches) on Sunday. Winners of each flight will be determined by total points obtained in your team's five matches with points being awarded for each nine-hole match as follows: (1) One point for each hole won in a match. One-half point for each hole that is halved. All nine holes must be played. (2) One point for each match won and one-half point for each match halved.

Winning teams of each flight will play a 5-hole Shootout to determine the overall tournament winner.

Teams/Flights/Handicaps:

Two-man teams consisting of a Fox Haven member and his guest. There will be 6 flights of 6 two-man teams. Each team will play a nine-hole, better ball match against each of the other teams in their flight. Play will be at 100% of USGA handicaps.

Prizes/Meals:

The winning team of each flight will receive a \$200 gift certificate. Overall winner will also receive a framed course flag with players autographs.

Each player will receive a tee prize that will be redeemed in the pro shop.

**All alcohol will be free all weekend as well as complimentary breakfast both day that will include a small buffet. Saturday night will include dinner for players and spouses (spouses will be charged \$20). Buffet lunch will be served Saturday and Sunday.**

Entry Fee:

\$250 per team. **Entry fee includes a tee prize, alcohol during play both Sat./Sun, mixed drinks during happy hour and dinner as well as lunch both days plus dinner Sat night.** A practice round the week of the tournament is included. **Important Note: The tournament will be limited to the first 36 paid teams.**

Our previous Member-Guest tournaments proved to be highly successful and great fun with full fields. You are encouraged to send in your entry form as soon as possible.

## Format

The format for the Member-Guest will be a point system tournament. There will be six flights with each flight consisting of six teams. Each team will play five 9-hole matches within its flight. Three matches will be played Saturday and two matches played Sunday. After the matches are concluded, the flight winners will play in a 5-hole Shootout to determine the overall tournament winning team.

All matches will be a shotgun start and all 9-hole matches will be played entirely on the front or back nines exclusively. If you start on the front nine, after finishing hole #9, go to hole #1. If you start on the back nine, after finishing hole #18, go to hole #10.

## Point System

Each flight will play a round robin with each team playing a 9-hole match against every other team in it's flight. Play will be based on one best ball of you and your partner. Play will be at 100% of your tournament handicap. Each match will be wheeled off the low handicap. Each player will receive his strokes where they fall on the scorecard, regardless of the starting hole. Strokes will be indicated by a slash mark on the scorecard.

The scoring is as follows:

- Zero (0) points for a hole lost
- Half (1/2) point for a hole tied
- One (1) point for a hole won
- One (1) extra point for a team winning match
- Half (1/2) extra point for each team if match is all square

In each match, team's are limited to winning 6 holes, or 7 points (6 points for the holes + 1 point for winning the match). The losing team will always receive 3 points.

**For Pace of Play: Please Pick Up When You Are Out of the Hole.**

## Handicaps

100% of the most current U.S.G.A. handicap will be used. Since the matches are nine holes, 50% of your 18 hole handicap will be used as your tournament handicap. Note: ½ strokes will be used. (Example: If your handicap is 17, your nine hole handicap would be 8 ½ . Handicaps will be wheeled off of the low handicap in the match. Handicaps will be verified with your club and/or via the internet using your GHIN number. The tournament committee has the right to review and adjust all handicaps at any point in the event.

## Scoring

Each team will receive a scorecard prior to teeing off showing stroke holes for it's team and the opponents team. Each team should verify correctness of handicaps and stroke holes. Each team will be responsible for keeping track of holes won or lost on the scorecard. After the match, one team member signs the opponent's scorecard as scorer and one team member signs their scorecard to attest.

## Forfeits or Withdrawals

After the beginning of match number one, should either the member of the guest have to withdraw from the tournament, that member or guest may be replaced by an equivalent player as approved by the tournament committee, prior to the beginning of match number four.

No substitution will be allowed after match four begins. Should a withdrawal occur during or after the beginning of any match, the remaining team member may continue in the tournament as a one man team. If both team members withdraw during a match, the withdrawing team will receive zero (0) points and their opponent will receive the greater of five (5) points or the number of points earned at the time of withdrawal.

If a team withdraws from the tournament, all of the remaining matches will be forfeited and the scheduled opponent for each match will receive a bye and be awarded five (5) points. Any team forfeiting a match will not be eligible for prizes.

## Inclement Weather

All decisions concerning weather will be made by the tournament committee.

## Rules

**TEES: Members will play from tees where handicaps were established. Guests will play from Foxhaven tees which closest correspond to their home course tees where their handicaps were established. The tournament committee has the right to review and adjust player's tees throughout the tournament.**

1. U.S.G.A. rules will govern play.
2. Any team member who is late cannot participate in the hole if any player in the group has hit a second shot.
3. The embedded ball rule shall apply through the green.
4. Water hazards are marked by yellow stakes and/or lines. Lateral hazards are marked by red stakes and/or lines.
5. Out-of-bounds is marked by white stakes and/or lines.
6. If in doubt as to a procedure, play a second ball.
7. Record accumulated points on scorecard, sign and return cards to clubhouse.

## Flight Winners

Each flight will consist of six teams. Flight winners will be the teams with the most cumulative points after the completion of the final match. In case of ties, the tie will be broken first by head-to-head total points, and second by a chip-off (both team members chip). The winner in any three way tie will be determined first by the total points won in the 3 team round robin for those teams, and second by a chip-off.

## Prizes

Each member from the winning team of each flight will receive a \$100 gift certificate from the pro shop as well as an etched glass trophy. Each member of the overall tournament winning team (winner of the Shootout) will receive a \$100 gift certificate and a larger etched glass trophy.

All players will receive a tee prize of a logoed golf shirt at time of registration.

All meals served are included in the entry fee. Alcoholic beverages are not included in the cost of meals.

## Shootout – Tournament Winner

1. The Shootout will be played by the winning teams of each flight.
2. The Shootout will be played over five holes (#1, #2, #7, #8, #9) with one team being eliminated on each hole.
3. The format will be two-man alternate shot. Player "A" tees off on all odd numbered holes, Player "B" tees off on all even numbered holes.
4. All play is net. Team handicaps will consist of one-half of combined handicaps, rounded down.
5. Teams will receive their handicap strokes where they fall on the scorecard.
6. Ties on holes will be determined by a chip-off. Both team members will chip. Closest single chip nearest the hole wins the hole for the team.

The Member-Guest Tournament Winner will be the last team remaining in the Shootout.
